## **Community Membership Details**

Community Membership is offered as a family Membership (all members of household are members).

Access to Swimming Pool – Community members can bring 4 guests to the Club and to the pool. Please contact a Board Member for larger guest numbers prior to bringing them to CYC.

Community members are allowed to use the boat ramp for small boats, such as kayaks, canoes and wave runners. Boats > 18 feet and requiring a trailer will be charged a launch fee of \$10 on the honor system (submit to CYC Treasurer).

A Community member may use an empty water slip (check with the Measurer for vacancies) for a day visit without charge. Overnight visits are allowed and must pay the transient, non-member rate. Check with the Measurer for specifics.

Access to the Clubhouse for social activities, getting ice, storing an item temporarily in the refrigerator, using the restrooms, etc., is permitted. Community Members must request special permission to rent a cottage, clubhouse rooms or the Bean Room.

Community members can and are encouraged to serve on committees (e.g., Buildings and Grounds, Membership), but cannot serve on the Board of Trustees or vote on Club issues. They are welcome to attend CYC member meetings.

Members will abide by the by-laws and the dock and pool rules as well as any other rules and policies that CYC has (see directory for complete set).

Community members need to become Active members to accrue seniority or ask for reciprocity with other Yacht Clubs.

Cost for Community membership is \$700 per year (billable in two payments) plus a one-time application fee of \$25. A one-year minimum membership is required. The current maximum number of Community memberships is 30, unless increased by the CYC members.
